


## STEPS TO DIVE INTO A 508 COMPLIANT PDF FILE

The 508 compliant PDF will have every individual section tagged as a unit.

You can see those sections individualized if you click on the Accessibility tags icon on the right-hand menu:



If the Accessibility tags icon is not visible, right click on the bar and select it:




The users of 508 compliant documents typically have their own apps for "Read out loud", or even a Braille pad that will convert the on-screen text into Braille.

The 508 tagging will help those tools to select and "feed" the content into those tools in sections that are usable and "searchable" and easy to navigate.

You can try it with the "Read out loud" function from Adobe.

To turn it on, go to: Menu/View/Read out loud/Activate read out loud:

Once the option is turned on, when you click inside the document on each section, the AI will start reading it to you, and it will move from one tagged section to another, which are typically marked with a black box in this image:
